## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2024**

**UK Power Networks works.** 

To allow electrical connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Newtown Road, Ashford.

A closure is planned from 22nd July 2024, with estimated completion by 5th September 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50079702576-01 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Newtown Road will be closed from the junction with Romney Marsh Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while electrical connection works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Newtown Road, Romney Marsh Road, Kimberley Way, Romney Marsh Road Roundabout, A2042 Bad Munstereifel Road, A2070 J A2042 Join S, Bad Munstereifel Slip East Bound Off, Bad Munstereifel Slip East Bound On, A2070 From J A2042 To M20 J10 Roundabout N, The Boulevard, Crowbridge Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
